Blocks 1-18 Our days should start at 8am and end no later than 7pm . Our days should be filled with one of the following:

1. Travel to and from any insitutions
2. Prison crusades (In a 14 day trip we should be able to do 10-12 prison services)
3. Meeting with government officials
4. Training conferences (Conferences can be 4, 6, 8 hours in length- in a 14 day trip we should be able to do 2 long conferences or 3 short conferences

Blocks 20, 21, 22 Should consist of:

1. Cultural experience out in the community
2. Dinner at a community leaders house
3. Encouragement seminar with a select group of keys leaders
4. Prayer walk

Good bye dinner: Should be planned for the 2nd to last night and should include only key leaders and their spouses.

Shopping: The American team will want to buy some gifts for their families and their donors . Please plan on finding a place where they might be able to buy some crafts of your country

Notes:

Obuasi prison on lockdown, so we bypassed the city and went directly to Kumasi. Even though we had a deposit (we tried to get it back but no go) it would have meant 6 hours of driving to and fro and fuel alone would have been more expensive. Next time if Obuasi is visited the team should still stay in Kumasi two nights; there is time to do the service and still get to Kumasi before dark.

Major mistake setting up a travel day for 540 miles. Next time need to confirm road conditons and route. This caused travel after dark and was also physically taxing.
